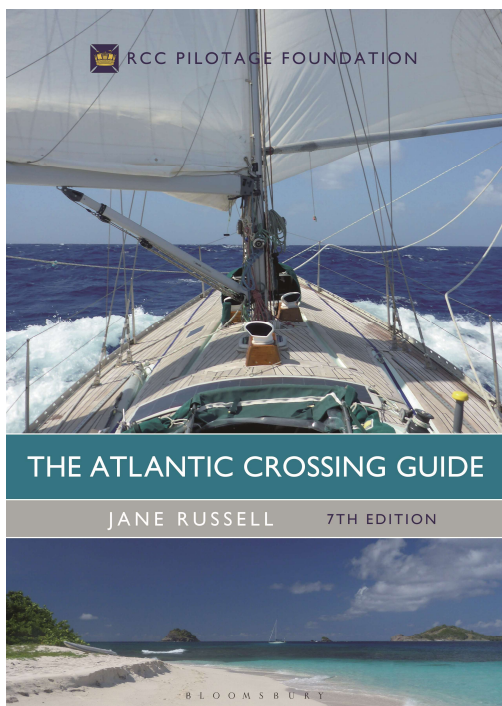


Meet Jane Russell, author of the Atlantic Crossing Guide, on the ChartCo Stand LB032 10th January at 1200.
